All-Day Club Demonstration

During my demonstration, I cover base information about coloring on wood:

- Sample pieces or photos (projection/TV required)
 - Survey of different coloring styles from assorted artists and my own works
- Coloring resources review
 - o Books
 - o DVDs
 - Websites
 - Other literature
- Considerations relating to color on wood
 - Wood selection
 - Paint and dye selection
 - Bleaching
 - o Etc.

I will then cover airbrush basics:

- Selection of equipment and options
 - Airbrush choices
 - Air source choice
 - Other required equipment (hoses, etc.)
 - Useful optional equipment
- Airbrush maintenance and cleaning
 - What are the parts of the airbrush and their functions
 - How to disassemble and clean the airbrush
 - How to inspect for wear and damage.
- Beginning Techniques Airbrush drills and techniques
 - How to hold the airbrush
 - How to paint lines, dots, arcs, circles, dagger strokes
 - How to paint 3D images sides and curves
- Intermediate Techniques Airbrush effects
 - Setting sun sky
 - Blending colors
 - Matching colors
 - Special paints
 - Templates
 - Design transfer techniques
 - Frisket and tape use

Many people are interested in achieving a glassy finish like Don Derry gets on his colored pieces. I demonstrate the techniques involved in that process:

- Wood prep
- Color application
- Lacquer application
- Polishing technique



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Finally, I would do a project to demonstrate the actual application of techniques:

- Image transfer
- Masking taped and handheld masking
- Knife preparation and cutting
- Airbrushing the image
- Completing the project (club raffle item)
